Sadie Ruben	<i>Alien Fetus Series</i>	Wall/Floor piece -- requires 16" x 48" long shelf or pedestal
Monica Bock	<i>Afterbirth (Sac Fluid Cord)</i>	Wall/Floor piece -- requires 24" x 48" long shelf or pedestal

Security requirements include a single-use locked space and electronic security and fire alarm systems in operation 24 hours a day.
